3. Principals' Report

Mid-High Principal's Report

a. Elementary Campus Update - Hal Curties

 Next School Year - Starting September using our green calendar, which means everything is back to normal. Will have volunteers and parents back in the school. This means we can regroup Math and Language Arts. Will no longer have to stagger recesses. Will be putting afternoon recess back in place. Grade 1 going into Grade 2 and Grade 3 going into Grade 4 will have the same teachers. Moving forward as a new normal. School will have 420 students and a full complement of staff. Focus will shift back to gifted from the inside out vs. supporting the students during the pandemic. Has some good PED lined up for both campuses. Parent teacher interviews will be a mix of online and in person

- Attendance Experienced high levels of absences in May, but we are back to normal
- **Drama** Wizard of Oz is going on tonight. Phenomenal experience for kids that are not normally in the spotlight.
- Clothing Donation 3 boxes full of clothing collected by the Eco Warriors that will be donated
- **Year-End Events** Friday a big day. Coffee talk in the morning and year end celebration. Sports day June 17th, first one in 2 years.

b. Mid-High Campus Update - Graeme Finlay
