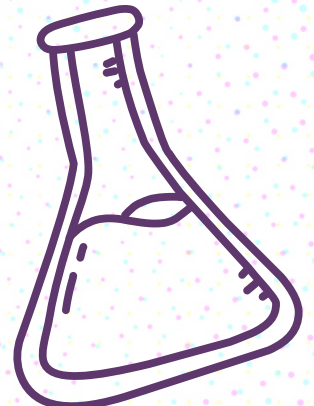
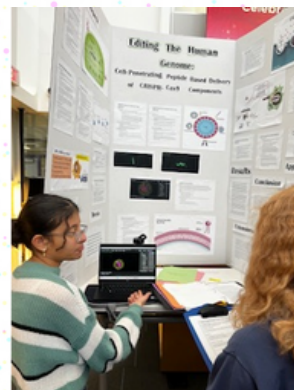
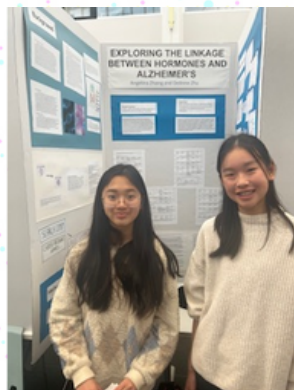
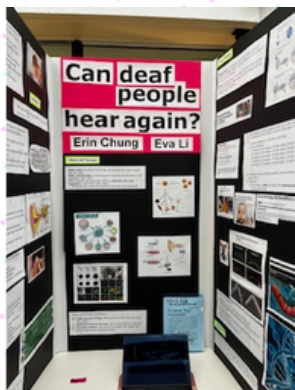
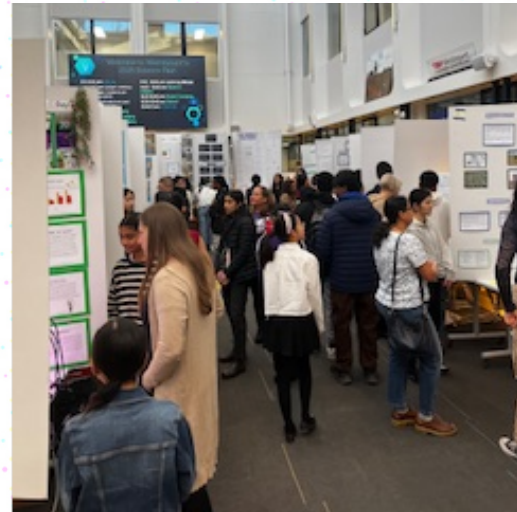


## Science Fair
